

A Forest Bioeconomy Framework for Canada



VISION

Canada will be a global leader in the use of forest biomass. Providing sustainable solutions for advanced bioproducts, climate change mitigation, building design, and community resilience will foster a culture change that promotes greater innovation and a highly competitive forest industry.

ENGAGEMENT

In the fall of 2016, the CCFM convened a campaign of engagement to garner views on a vision for Canada's forest bioeconomy and low-carbon future, particularly with nontraditional stakeholders. Over 350 people contributed through in-person sessions held across the country or online.

PURPOSE

The Framework's aim is to advance forest sector innovation in Canada through collaboration, engagement, and mobilization, and is a key deliverable under the CCFM Innovation Action Plan (2016–2020). The Framework outlines a comprehensive approach to catalyzing bioeconomy activities and investments.
