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POTENTIAL

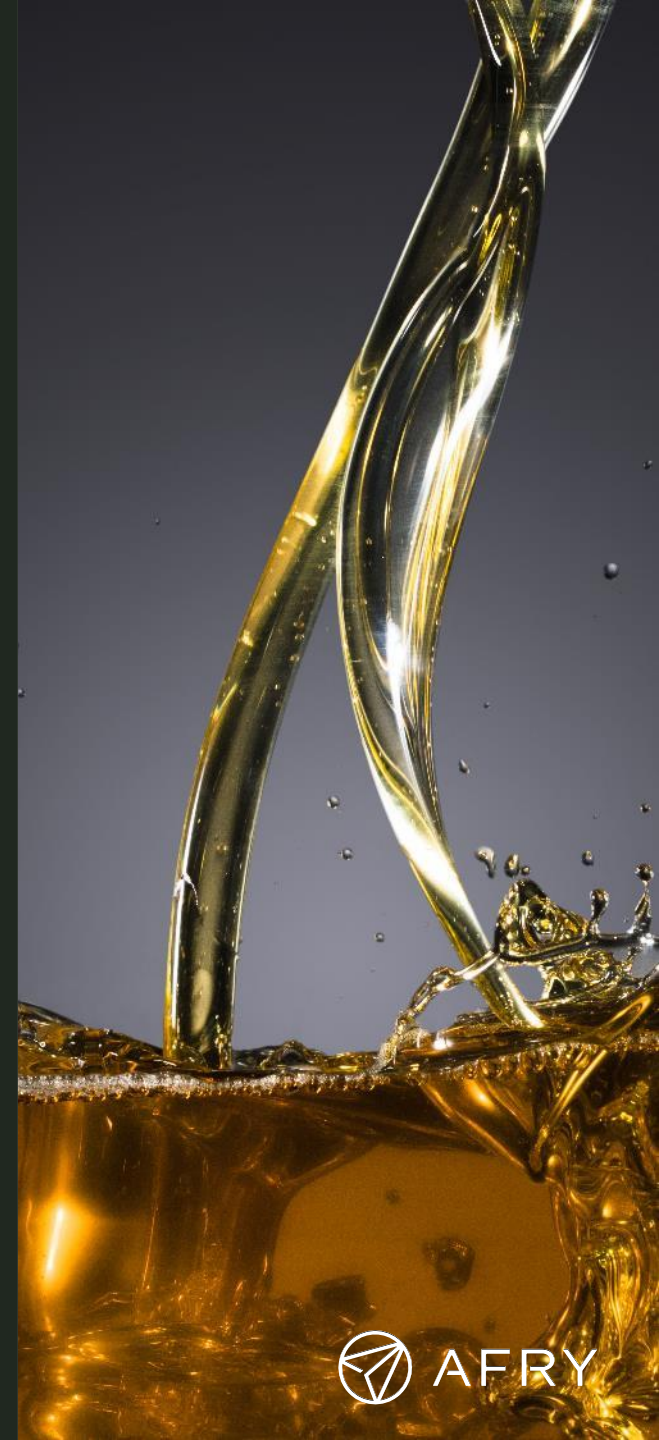


By 2030, a refinery in Eastern Canada could integrate 5–10% renewable feedstock sourced from Ontario's forest biomass

....which would translate to

1 – 2 million ODT of woody biomass per year

Feedstock in the form of biocrude can be cost-competitive with conventional biofuels, but their large-scale deployment will require substantial capital investment



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
